- The record for the shortest duration was 41 days, in 1981.
- The record for the longest duration was 106 days, in 2011.
- The earliest a restriction period started was on February 16, 2011.
- The latest a restriction period started was on March 29, 2014.
- The earliest date they have been lifted was April 22, 2010.
- The latest date they have been lifted was June 02, 2014 and 2015.
