2015 BUDGET HEARING

The Board of County Road Commissioners of Iron County held a Budget Hearing Tuesday, December 9, 2014 at 10:30 a.m. in the Road Commission office at 800 West Franklin Street, Iron River, Michigan.

The purpose of the hearing was to review the proposed 2015 fiscal year budget.

Vice Chair Sabol called the meeting to order.

Present for the meeting were Vice Chairman Joe Sabol, Members Ernest Schmidt, Chris Sholander and Charles Battan, Superintendent/Manager Douglas Tomasoski Finance Director/Clerk Lisa Powell and Attorney Mark Tousignant. Chairman Dan Germic was absent.

The Board reviewed the proposed 2015 fiscal year budget as prepared by the administrative staff. Superintendent Tomasoski explained the road projects scheduled for 2015 and discussed the anticipated revenues and expenditures for the upcoming year. At 11:00 am Attorney Mark Tousignant excused himself from the meeting.

Discussion took place regarding the chip seal program that is being contemplated and the existing gravel program and how it will be tied to the budget and winter expenditures. Tomasoski reminded all that there is only one pie and if one area has increased spending than another area will have to show decreased spending with winter maintenance having a big impact on whether the pie slice will be there for use on local roads projects.

At 12:10 p.m., it was motioned by Commissioner Sholander and supported by Commissioner Schmidt to adjourn the Budget Hearing.
