
**COMMISSIONERS' COMMENTS**

And he enjoys seeing the Foremen present, so they can see the how and why of what is done in the meetings.


At 9:28 a.m. with no further business to come before the Board, it was motioned by Germic, supported by Schmidt, to adjourn the regular meeting.
