#### SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT

Interim Supr. Toivonen reviewed his report:

Fuel Update- Plan to order fuel for Iron River today.

Gravel-Iron City Crushing is moving equipment into the Amasa Pit the week of 5/13 to begin stripping and then begin crushing shortly after.

#### Primary Roads:

CR 424 Phase 6- UPEA was awarded the bid for inspection/engineering on the three MDOT projects as they were the only bidder.

Baumgartner Phase 4- UPEA was awarded the bid for inspection/engineering on the three MDOT projects as they were the only bidder. Precon meeting is scheduled for May 23<sup>rd</sup>, with a project start date of June 8<sup>th</sup>.

Brule Mountain Rd Phase 5- UPEA was awarded the bid for inspection/engineering on the three MDOT projects as they were the only bidder. Precon meeting was held May 9th with a project start date of May 15<sup>th</sup>. Paving will be done before Memorial Day and the project completed within the first week of June.

Pavement Marking- Sent a package to PK Contracting yesterday for pavement markings to be done on Bates-Amasa, CR 424 bike path and crosswalk areas and a crosswalk at Stager Lake Park.

FHWA-ER Program 2023 Flooding-Everything is going smoothly with surveys and permitting through UPEA. Resolutions are on the agenda today for the MDOT contracts to get reimbursement. Baumgartner needs a grading easement to go outside the ROW and it may be necessary to do some wetland mitigation due to the culvert extensions.

#### Local Roads:

2024 Local Projects-Bacco was awarded all three projects and has a tentative start date of early to mid-June. Residents were worried about ensuring the fiber optic was run before the paving was done. These concerns were shared with JSI and Midway, but their contractors are planning on the fiber optic installation being done in the fall.

Misc. Township Work- Ed Benson, Bates Twp., reached out about some issues with sewer line in the Rogers Location and at the intersection of Sunset Lake and Section 16 where repairs are needed. Brad will work with him to get repairs made.

Old M-69-It was discovered that there was a chain across Old M-69 a few months back; it was removed. Last week, the chain was back across the road. A certified letter was sent to the property owner giving them 30 days to remove it and they called yesterday for more information.

Legislative Appropriations- The Emergency Managers from the six affected Counties sent a letter to Lansing requesting more funding to help pay for repairs from the 2023 flooding.

Section 19 Funding-Michelle attended a virtual meeting with MSP and the other affected counties; we were informed that there is no funding available at this time.

#### Equipment:

Delivery is still expected in July for both chassis.

Radios- Dean is getting pricing for simple two-way radios to be used by the crack sealing and flagging crews.

Quad axel boxes are on order.

GPS Tracking-A virtual meeting was held with Samsara on March 10<sup>th</sup>. They are willing to provide some units to try out for a month at no cost. Ontonagon is also looking into this as well.

#### Employment:

HEOP- Two of the new hires started on April 22<sup>nd</sup>, with the third starting on May 13<sup>th</sup>. The new Mechanic is working out great. Four interviews are scheduled for May 23<sup>rd</sup> for the HR-PR Admin. position.

Job Fair- Forman Rob Johnson is attending the Job Fair at Forest Park today. He will be giving information about the HEOP position, benefits provided by the road commission, and temporary summer employment opportunities. Midwest Trucking School out of Escanaba provided us with pamphlets and brochures about their CDL program to present as well. Looking at expanding the summer positions to 18-year-old high schoolers that are not college bound in hopes of attracting new interest. Dickinson RC has an apprenticeship program that we may be interested in looking at.

#### Bridges:

Idlewild Rd.-Fortune Cr.-Bridge program application submitted on March 28<sup>th</sup> for 2027 construction. Application is verified as received and determinations will be made in October.

FH-16 N & S. Branches Paint River-Bridge program applications submitted March 28<sup>th</sup> for 2027 construction. Application is verified as received and determinations will be made in October.

Wild Rivers-Iron River Culvert Crossing- Bette Premo did submit paperwork for the grant.

#### Miscellaneous:

MCRCSIP- Safety training was held last Monday.

Iron Co. Emergency Meeting- When the explosion occurred in Iron River earlier this year, emergency response personnel had no way to get fuel locally. The road commission was able to assist at that time and it was decided going forward to allow emergency personnel to obtain fuel from the road commission, in emergency situations only, by contacting the closest ICRC Foreman.

Seasonal Weight Restrictions: Restrictions were lifted county-wide on April 29th.

Fiber Optic: AEG-Approximately 50 permits have been approved, both along US 141 in Crystal Falls Twp. and in Hematite Twp. The process is going smoothly. JSI/Midway have been given the Third-Party Inspection agreement that will be forwarded to GEI once it has been signed.

Teamsters-We will be having a meeting with the Union rep and Stewards in June to get more information on health insurance plans. Ernie would like to attend.

County-Wide Road Millage-Chairman Schmidt and Interim Supt. Toivonen attended last months County Board Meeting, where the millage language for the road commission renewal in November was approved.

Fahrner Emulsion Demo-Fahrner Laboratory is working on an emulsion type for us that would help with dust control. We would do the grading/rolling prep work for the test section of road for them to provide the test strip on.

Perma-Zyme Demo-Ken Colby is also offering to do a test strip at no cost to us. The details are still being worked out, but ideally, we would run this test at the end of the Fahrner test strip for comparison.

Drain Commissioner- Chairman Schmidt and Interim Supt. Toivonen attended the County Board meeting last month, to discuss moving drain commission duties back to the County. The County declined to do so but did suggest hiring it out if we did not have the manpower needed. We have been extensively monitoring the lake levels because of the lack of spring run-off. The boards went in at Stager Lake and Fortune Lake on May 1<sup>st</sup>, as per the court order. Sunset Lake is still above normal level thus the board is still out currently. There was discussion about hiring it out, as suggested by the County. Commissioner Frailing questioned the amount the County is willing to fund for the position as the current \$10,000 annual budget is not enough to pay someone to perform the duties and he understands the funding is not unlimited. Commissioner Bruette will bring it back to the County Board for more discussion and detail on funding. Brad is looking to attend a drain commission conference to get further education and information.

#### **DELEGATIONS**

Mastodon Township: Dave Smith, Trustee, asked a few questions about chloride and rolling gravel roads. He also suggested that we talk to our Legislative representatives regarding after-hours credit card gas purchases and the problems we experience here with emergencies. A few years ago, Michigan legislators had come close to passing a bill to allow it, much like Wisconsin, but it failed. He experienced issues at the fire department with obtaining fuel after hours as well.

- e. Safety-Commissioner Battan praised both garages as to how neat and clean they always are, which is very good for safety and appearance.
- g. Parks and Recreation-Drain Commission-Commissioner Germic relayed there was a meeting held and they are still looking into a way to get Cooks Run going. They are going ahead with the Chicagoan Lake boat landing, and this is the first year for the online reservation system at Pentoga Park. Additionally, there are two new members on the committee: Brian Fabbri and Seth Miatech.
- h. Personnel- Commissioner Schmidt relayed that interviews are being held next week for the HR-PR Administrator.
